Puffin egg

The Puffins lay their eggs from May to July. The males dig tunnels in the ground and the females lay their eggs at the end of the tunnel. The Puffins only lay one egg per breeding season. Nesting chambers are lined with dry plant material, the tunnels are often complex with many entrances. Incubation time is 39-42 days.
